Our Offerings

The St. Paul University Manila

Beginners, Elementary, Intermediate and Advanced
students to gain language proficiency and capability.

Beginner (BE 1,2, 3)	Students with little or no knowledge of English are introduced to the use of the alphabet and sounds of English; learn to speak, read and write using simple words and basic patterns of language and handling basic transactions. Levels 3&4 reprise basic language skills – speaking, reading, writing, listening, comprehension; developing vocabulary and conversation skills using correct tenses and various question patterns.
Intermediate (IE – 4,5,6)	More confident use of the language through increased familiarity with a range of structures, using them accurately in spoken as well as in written form. A strong program of idiom study is included as conversation moves from controlled to more open discussions.
Advanced (AE –7,8,9)	Assist students toward perfecting language proficiency and capability for academic or professional purposes in both written and oral forms. Students may choose from advanced specialized courses to complement their advanced grammar, or choose from the advanced courses only.
